

HOME & HOSPITAL TEACHING CONDITIONS OF SERVICE – PARENTS

Ongoing access to home visits is subject to regular review in accordance with written medical advice.

Parents/Carers:

1. Inform the teacher of any factors affecting their child's capacity to participate in the education program.
2. Provide a safe environment for the teacher to work in, including :-
 - smoke-free room
 - minimal risk of infection from household members
 - adequate safety precautions in place for misbehaving students
 - responsible adult on premises during teacher's visit
 - no threat from pets, outside and inside the house
3. Provide a suitable workspace for the teacher, including :-
 - chair and desk/table space with adequate light
 - minimal distractions (television/stereo noise, visitors, other children etc).
4. Give the teacher as much notice as possible of visit cancellations.
5. Assist in implementing the education program as required.
6. Authorise release of all documentation relevant to their child's education needs from the enrolled school, Regional Office, and any other agencies involved.

Teachers:

1. Understand and be sensitive to the individual needs of the student.
2. Work in partnership with parents/carers in implementing the education program.
3. Liaise and collaborate with other agencies involved as necessary.
4. Give parents/carers as much notice as possible of changing bookings or visit cancellations.
5. Assist with re-entry to school as necessary.
6. Act professionally and respect family privacy.
7. Liaise with Coordinating Teacher.
